

Easter Story Drawing Activity

Learning objective: To retell the Easter story through illustrations.

Use a variety of colours and shading to bring the Easter story to life.

Draw: Imagine the Easter story unfolding before your eyes. Draw a scene that shows the resurrection of Jesus Christ. Use a wide range of colours and patterns to make your picture vibrant and engaging. Include the following elements in your drawing: an empty tomb, angels, Jesus, and Easter eggs.



Label words: Egg · Cross · Resurrection · Rabbits · Easter Bonnet · Jesus · Tomb · Angels

Steps:

1. Draw a picture of the empty tomb where Jesus was buried.
2. Label the Easter bonnet that a child might wear on Easter Sunday.
3. Draw a picture of Jesus meeting the angels at the tomb.
4. What do the Easter eggs represent?
5. Label the cross on which Jesus was crucified.
