Learning objective: To expand vocabulary by replacing common, overused adjectives with more precise and descriptive synonyms.

Help Pip make the story more exciting by choosing a 'powerful' word from the word bank to replace the underlined boring word in each sentence. Write the new, improved sentence on the lines provided.

2. 2. The happy children cheered when the bell rang. (Replace 'happy') (1 mark)

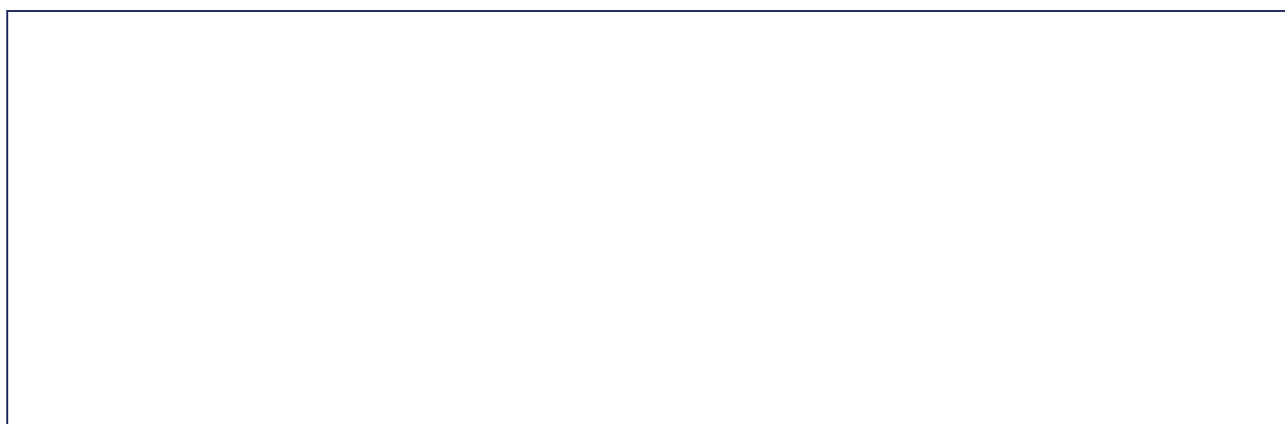
3. 3. After the long race, the runners were tired. (Replace 'tired') (1 mark)
