

Rosa's Animal Adventure: French Vocabulary Challenge

Learning objective: To identify and recall names of common animals in French and categorise them by their natural habitats.

Rosa the parrot has been flying all over the world! She has brought back a list of animals she met, but she has mixed up their French names and where they live. First, draw a line to match the French word to the correct English translation. Then, sort the animals into the table below based on where they usually live (the farm, the house, or the wild).

Word bank: un chien (dog) · un chat (cat) · un cheval (horse) · un lion (lion) · un oiseau (bird) · un lapin (rabbit)

1. Match the French animal to the English translation: (a) un chat - ?, (b) un cheval - ?, (c) un lapin - ? (3 marks)

2. Which animal from the word bank lives in a stable on a farm? (1 mark)

3. If you saw a 'lion' in the wild, what would you call it in French? (1 mark)

4. Rosa says 'un oiseau' can fly. Is this true or false? Write the English word for 'oiseau'. (2 marks)

5. Complete the table: Sort 'un chien', 'un lion', and 'un cheval' into their correct habitats (House, Farm, or Wild). (3 marks)

Draw: Draw your favourite animal from the list in its natural habitat and label it using its French name.



Extension challenge: Can you find out the French word for another animal not on this list? Write it down and draw a small picture to show what it is.
