

Rosa's Animal Adventure: French Assessment

Learning objective: To identify and describe animals in French, including using articles and adjectives correctly.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank to help you with your spellings. Write your answers in French where indicated.

Rosa the parrot is visiting the village park. She sees many friends today. She spots a small white rabbit near a tree, a big red bird sitting on a branch, and a friendly dog playing on the grass. Rosa loves to name every animal she sees in French!

Word bank: un chien (dog) · un chat (cat) · un lapin (rabbit) · un oiseau (bird) · un poisson (fish) · un serpent (snake) · grand (big) · petit (small) · bleu (blue) · rouge (red) · est (is) · et (and)

1. Rosa sees a cat and a dog. Write the French words for 'a cat' and 'a dog'. (2 marks)

2. If an animal is 'small', which French adjective do we use? Write it below. (1 mark)

3. Translate this sentence into French: 'The bird is big.' (3 marks)

4. Explain why we use 'un' before some animal names. What does 'un' mean in English? (4 marks)

5. Rosa spots a fish. Describe the fish using three French words (e.g., the animal and two adjectives like colour or size). (4 marks)

6. Extended Writing: Rosa meets a new animal at the park. Write 3-4 sentences in French describing the animal. Include its name, its size, and its colour. Use the word 'et' to join your ideas. (11 marks)

Draw: Draw your favourite animal in the box below and label it with its French name and one adjective (e.g., 'un chat petit').
