

Rosa's Rainbow Art Gallery

Learning objective: To learn and identify French vocabulary for colours and use them to describe items.

Rosa the parrot has painted a beautiful gallery, but she has mixed up her labels! Look at the list of colours below. Match the French colour word to the correct English translation by drawing a line, then use the colours to complete the sentences about the items in the gallery.

Word bank: rouge · bleu · jaune · vert · orange · violet · noir · blanc

1. Match the French word to the English colour: rouge (red), bleu (blue), jaune (yellow), vert (green), noir (black), blanc (white). (6 marks)

2. Rosa has a parrot friend. If the parrot is green, write the sentence in French: 'Le perroquet est...' (2 marks)

3. If the sun in your drawing is yellow, write the sentence in French: 'Le soleil est...' (2 marks)

4. Rosa sees a black cat. How would you write 'The cat is black' in French? (2 marks)

5. Think of a white cloud. How would you describe it using 'Le nuage est...'? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of a garden scene including a red flower, a blue sky, and a yellow sun. Label each item in your drawing using the correct French colour word.



Extension challenge: Choose two colours from the word bank and write a short sentence in French describing your favourite items using those colours (e.g., 'La pomme est rouge').
