

Rosa's Family Tree: La Famille

Learning objective: To identify and use French vocabulary for family members and describe family relationships.

Read the passage about Rosa the parrot's family. Use the word bank to help you answer the questions below in English or French as requested.

Bonjour! I am Rosa. Today, I want to introduce you to ma famille. My mother is called Clara and my father is called Hugo. I have one brother named Pablo and one little sister named Mia. We live in a big tree! My grand-père is very wise and tells us stories, and my grand-mère loves to fly with us. We are a very happy family.

Word bank: la mère (mother) · le père (father) · le frère (brother) · la sœur (sister) · le grand-père (grandfather) · la grand-mère (grandmother) · la famille (family)

1. Who are the two people Rosa mentions as her parents? (2 marks)

2. Translate 'le frère' and 'la sœur' into English. (2 marks)

3. How many siblings does Rosa have in total? List their names. (2 marks)

4. If Rosa had a cousin, what French word would you use to describe her family members? (1 mark)

5. Why does Rosa mention her grand-père in the story? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of your own family or a family of animals. Label each person or animal using the French words from the word bank.



Extension challenge: Write three sentences in French to describe your family, for example: 'Voici mon père. Il s'appelle [Name].'
