

Rosa's French Food Feast

Learning objective: To identify and use French vocabulary for common foods and express likes and dislikes using 'j'aime' and 'je n'aime pas'.

Read the French words provided in the word bank and complete the activities below to help Rosa the parrot prepare for her picnic.

Word bank: une pomme (an apple) · le fromage (cheese) · le chocolat (chocolate) · une carotte (a carrot) · le pain (bread) · le poulet (chicken) · j'aime (I like) · je n'aime pas (I do not like)

1. Rosa is packing her picnic. Write the correct French word for these items: 1) Cheese, 2) Apple, 3) Bread. (3 marks)

2. Translate these sentences into English: 'J'aime le chocolat' and 'Je n'aime pas la carotte'. (2 marks)

3. If you were choosing a healthy snack from the list for a school lunch, which would you pick? Write your choice in French and explain why in one English sentence. (2 marks)

4. Max the monkey wants to buy a sandwich for £3.50 and an apple for 50p. How much does his lunch cost in total? Write the total in words (in English). (2 marks)

5. Write a sentence in French to say what you like to eat and a sentence to say what you do not like to eat. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picnic basket and fill it with at least four items from the word bank. Label each item with its correct French name.



Extension challenge: Research one other French food item that isn't in the word bank. Write the French word, the English translation, and draw a small picture of it.
