- Use 'Bonjour' when you see your teacher in the morning to say hello politely.
- 'Salut' is a great, casual way to say hi or bye to your best friends.
- Ask 'Comment ça va?' to show interest in how your friends are feeling today.
- If it is getting dark outside, switch from 'Bonjour' to 'Bonsoir' to say good evening.
- Always remember to say 'Merci' when someone helps you or gives you something.
- Use 'Au revoir' when the lesson is finished to say goodbye to everyone in the room.

Did you know? Did you know? In France, when people greet friends or family, they often use a polite 'la bise', which is a gentle touch of cheeks, but in a classroom setting, a friendly wave and a clear 'Bonjour' is the perfect way to start your day!
