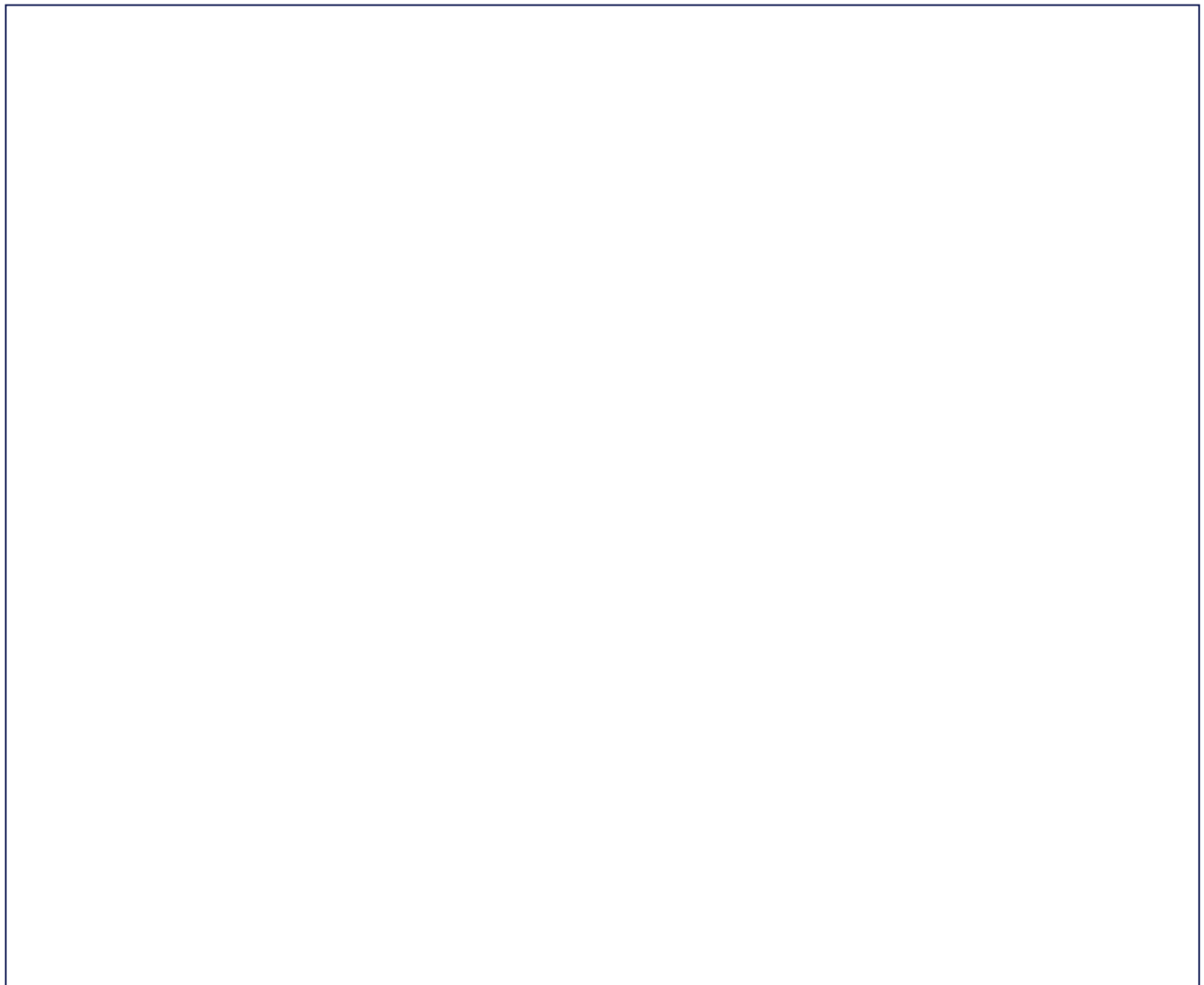


Rosa's School Day: Ma Journée à l'École

Learning objective: To recall and use French vocabulary related to school subjects and classroom objects.

Rosa the parrot is ready to learn! Use the word bank to label your drawing and show what is inside your perfect classroom. Make sure to use the correct French articles (un, une, le, la) where possible.

Draw: Draw a bright, colourful, and busy classroom scene. Include a teacher's desk, student tables, a chalkboard, and a small library area with bookshelves. Ensure there is plenty of white space around the objects for the students to write their French labels clearly. Draw Rosa the parrot sitting on a perch near the window.



Label words: un stylo (a pen) · un cahier (an exercise book) · une règle (a ruler) · la salle de classe (the classroom) · la bibliothèque (the library) · les maths (maths) · le français (French)

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large classroom. Label the room 'la salle de classe'.
2. Step 2: Draw a desk with an exercise book and a pen on it. Label them using the word bank.
3. Step 3: Draw a bookshelf in the corner and label it 'la bibliothèque'.
4. Step 4: Draw a blackboard with a maths calculation on it. Label the board 'les maths'.
5. Step 5: Rosa the parrot is visiting! Draw her anywhere in the room and write a speech bubble for her saying 'Bonjour!'.
