

Rosa's Market Adventure: Le Marché

Learning objective: To learn French vocabulary for fruit, vegetables, and prices, and to practise asking for items in a market setting.

Rosa the parrot is visiting a colourful French market! Use the word bank to help Rosa complete her shopping list. First, match the French item name to its English translation. Then, complete the shopping dialogue by filling in the blanks with the correct words. Finally, calculate the total cost for Rosa's basket using the prices provided.

Word bank: une pomme (an apple) · une banane (a banana) · une carotte (a carrot) · des fraises (strawberries) · S'il vous plaît (Please) · Combien coûte (How much does... cost?) · Ça fait (That comes to...) · £1.50 · £2.00 · £3.50
