

Rosa's French Time Challenge

Learning objective: To tell the time in French using o'clock, half past, and quarter past/to.

Read each question carefully. Rosa the parrot wants to see how well you know your French clock vocabulary. Write your answers clearly in French where requested.

Rosa is planning her busy day in the forest! She needs your help to make sure she knows exactly when her lessons and snack times are. Remember, in French, we use the phrase 'Il est...' to start our sentences when telling the time.

Word bank: Il est... · heure · et quart · et demie · moins le quart · une · deux · trois · quatre · cinq · six · sept · huit · neuf · dix · onze · douze

1. Translate these times into French: 1. 3:00 (Trois heures) 2. 6:00 (Six heures) (2 marks)

2. Write the French phrase for 'half past' and use it in a sentence for 4:30. (3 marks)

3. If it is 7:15, how do you say that in French using the 'et quart' structure? (3 marks)

4. Explain why we use 'moins le quart' for a time like 8:45. What does 'moins' mean in this context? (4 marks)

5. Rosa has a snack at 10:15 and a flight lesson at 12:30. Write these two times in full French sentences. (4 marks)

6. Extended Writing: Imagine you are writing a diary entry for Rosa. Describe her schedule for the morning. Include at least four different times (e.g., 8:00, 8:15, 9:30, 10:45) using full French sentences. Ensure your grammar is correct. (9 marks)

Draw: Draw a clock showing 'Il est neuf heures et demie' and label the hands clearly. _____
