7. Which of the following oceans is NOT between the continents of Asia and Africa? (1 mark)

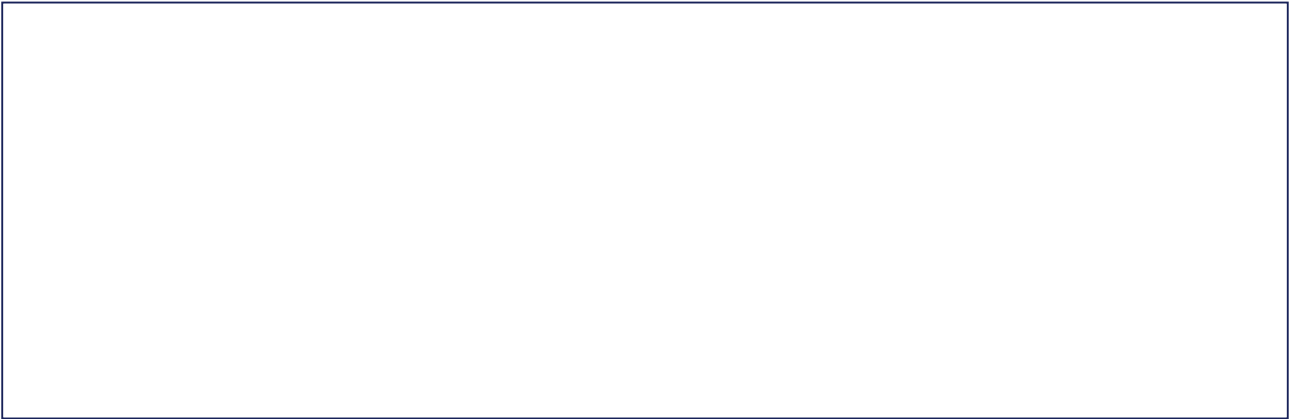
8. True or False: The Indian Ocean is the largest of the world's five oceans. (1 mark)
