Learning objective: To understand the names and locations of the seven continents and five oceans

1. What are the names of the seven continents? (2 marks)

2. Label the two oceans that border the continent of Europe on the map below. (2 marks)

3. Which ocean is the largest? (1 mark)

4. A child travelling from London to Sydney by plane would cross which two oceans? (2 marks)

5. Draw a map showing the continents of Africa and Asia and label their borders. (3 marks)

6. How many of the continents do not have a country with the word 'America' in its name? (1 mark)

Draw: Imagine you are a sailor on a ship crossing the Atlantic Ocean from Europe to North America. Draw a picture of your journey, including the continents and oceans you see along the way.



Extension challenge: Research and write a short paragraph about a country located on one of the continents. What is its capital city? What is its main language spoken? What are some of its famous landmarks?
