

Max's Rounding Adventure

Learning objective: To round any number to the nearest 10, 100, or 1000, and understand the rules of rounding.

Use these flashcards to test your knowledge of rounding numbers. Flip the card to check if your answer matches Max the Monkey's rounding rules!

What is the rule for rounding if the digit to the right is 0, 1, 2, 3, or 4?

Round down (the digit stays the same).

What is the rule for rounding if the digit to the right is 5, 6, 7, 8, or 9?

Round up (the digit increases by 1).

Round 43 to the nearest 10.

40

Round 67 to the nearest 10.

70

Round 125 to the nearest 100.

100

Round 850 to the nearest 100.

900

Round 1,499 to the nearest 1,000.

1,000

Round 7,501 to the nearest 1,000.

8,000

Max spends £4.60 at the shop. Round this amount to the nearest pound.

£5

If you are rounding 345 to the nearest 10, which column do you look at?

The ones column (the digit 5).

True or False: When rounding to the nearest 10, the answer will always end in a 0.
