

Max's Time-Tastic Maths Flashcards

Learning objective: To recall and use knowledge of time, including 12-hour and 24-hour clocks, durations, and calculating time intervals in years, months, weeks, days, hours, and minutes.

Use these flashcards to test your knowledge of time. Read the front of the card, think of the answer, then check the back to see if you are correct. Max the monkey says: 'Every second counts!'

How many minutes are in one hour?	If it is 2:15 pm on a 12-hour clock, what is the time in 24-hour format?
60 minutes.	14:15.
How many days are in a standard year?	If a film starts at 16:30 and lasts for 90 minutes, at what time does it finish?
365 days.	18:00 (or 6:00 pm).
How many months are in a year?	How many days are in a leap year?
12 months.	366 days.
What is the name for the time when it is 12:00 in the middle of the day?	If you wake up at 7:00 am and go to sleep at 9:00 pm, how many hours have passed?
Midday (or noon).	14 hours.
How many seconds are in one minute?	How many weeks are in a year?
60 seconds.	52 weeks.
If a train journey takes 2 hours and 20 minutes, how many minutes is that in total?	What is 10:45 am on a 24-hour clock?
140 minutes.	10:45.
