1. In which month is Black History Month celebrated in the UK? (1 mark)

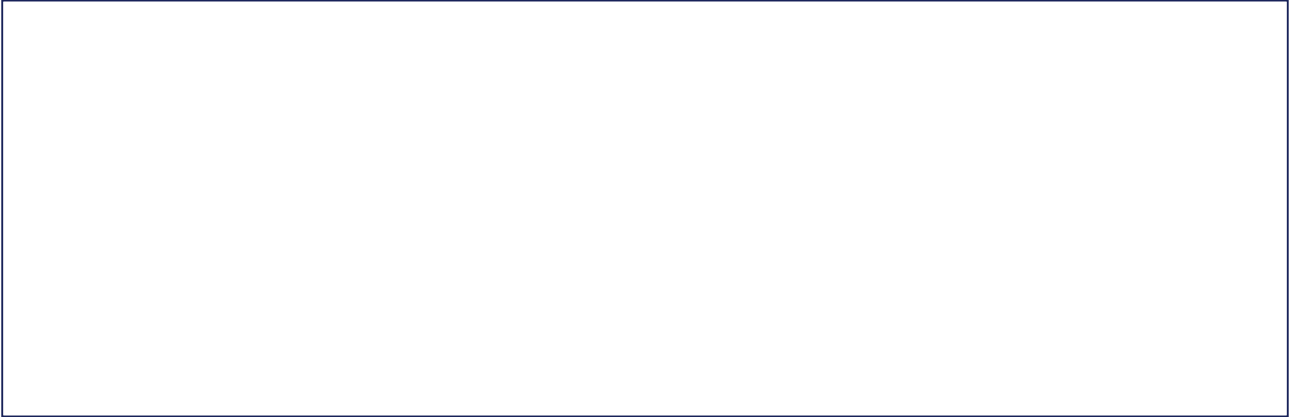
2. According to the text, what are two types of roles that Black individuals have held throughout history? (2 marks)
