Learning objective: To understand the key traditions, beliefs, and practices associated with Eid al-Fitr and Eid al-Adha.

3. Which items from the list are 'Values of Eid' (the feelings and beliefs)? (2 marks)

4. Why do you think giving to charity (Zakat) is an important part of Eid? (2 marks)

5. If you were inviting a friend to an Eid celebration, which two activities from the list would you be most excited to show them? (2 marks)

6. Eid al-Fitr marks the end of which special month of fasting? (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a picture of a festive Eid table. Include some delicious traditional foods and a gift you might give to a friend or family member.



Extension challenge: Imagine you have a budget of £10 to buy a small gift for someone you care about for Eid. Write down what you would buy and explain why this gift shows kindness or generosity.
