- A moral question is a question about whether an action is right or wrong, rather than just a question about a fact.
- A moral dilemma happens when someone has to choose between two options, and both might feel right or wrong in different ways.
- Values are the beliefs that help us decide what is important, such as honesty, kindness, and respect.
- When we think about morals, we often consider the consequences, which are the results of the choices we make.
- Fairness doesn't always mean everyone gets the exact same thing, but that everyone gets what they need to succeed.
- Talking about moral questions helps us understand other people's points of view and build a kinder community.
