Learning objective: To understand the importance of sacred texts in different religions and how they guide people's lives.

Pip the bookworm wants to learn about the holy books used in different faiths. Use your research to complete this fact-file. Fill in each section carefully to explain what a sacred text is and why it is special to the people who read it.

1. The Sacred Text: What is the name of the holy book you are studying, and which religion does it belong to? (2 marks)

2. Key Teachings: What are some of the most important messages or rules found within this text? (4 marks)

3. How it is Used: How do people show respect when handling this book, and where might it be kept? (3 marks)

4. Daily Life: How does reading this sacred text help a person make decisions or behave towards others in their daily life? (4 marks)

5. Stories and Parables: Describe a short story or a famous passage from the text. What is the lesson we can learn from it? (5 marks)

6. Comparing Texts: How is this sacred text similar to or different from another holy book you have learned about? (3 marks)

Extension challenge: Can you find a quote or a short verse from the sacred text that talks about kindness or peace? Write it out in your best handwriting and explain what it means.
