

Rosa's Rainbow Art Gallery

Learning objective: To identify and spell common colours in Spanish, applying them to describe objects in the world around us.

Rosa the parrot has been flying around the world and has brought back some colourful pictures for her gallery. However, she has mixed up the labels! Look at the objects described in the questions below. Match the correct Spanish colour word from the bank to the object, and write a short sentence in Spanish describing the object's colour. Remember, in Spanish, the colour word comes after the noun!

Word bank: rojo · azul · amarillo · verde · naranja · morado · blanco · negro

1. Rosa has found a bright sun. How do you describe a yellow sun in Spanish? (Clue: Sun is 'sol') (2 marks)

2. Rosa is looking at a green leaf. How do you describe a green leaf in Spanish? (Clue: Leaf is 'hoja') (2 marks)

3. Rosa found a red apple. How do you describe a red apple in Spanish? (Clue: Apple is 'manzana') (2 marks)

4. Rosa sees a blue sea. How do you describe a blue sea in Spanish? (Clue: Sea is 'mar') (2 marks)

5. Rosa spots a white cloud. How do you describe a white cloud in Spanish? (Clue: Cloud is 'nube') (2 marks)

Draw: Draw your favourite fruit or animal and label it with its Spanish colour. For example, if you draw a purple grape, write 'uva morada' next to it.



Extension challenge: Choose two colours from the word bank that were not used in the questions. Write a Spanish sentence for each one using an object of your choice, such as 'El coche es...' (The car is...) or 'El libro es...' (The book is...).
