

Rosa's Weekly Spanish Calendar

Learning objective: To learn and recall the seven days of the week in Spanish and present them creatively.

Rosa the parrot wants to keep track of her busy week! Follow the steps below to create your own illustrated Spanish calendar. Use the word bank to label each day correctly.

Draw: Draw a large, colourful flower with seven petals. In the centre of the flower, draw a picture of Rosa the parrot. In each petal, write one of the seven days of the week in Spanish. Decorate each petal with a small drawing that represents what you like to do on that day (e.g., a football for a Saturday, or a book for a Monday). Use bright colours to make your calendar stand out.



Label words: lunes · martes · miércoles · jueves · viernes · sábado · domingo

Steps:

1. Which day comes after 'lunes'? Write the Spanish word.
2. If today is 'viernes', what is the next day in Spanish?
3. Write the Spanish word for Sunday.
4. In Spanish, days of the week are not written with a capital letter unless they start a sentence. Why is this different from English?
5. Draw a small sun next to the day that means 'Saturday' in your calendar.
