

Rosa's Spanish Days of the Week Quiz

Learning objective: To recall and spell the seven days of the week in Spanish, understanding that they are not capitalised in Spanish sentences.

Join Rosa the parrot on her weekly tour! Read the questions carefully and test your memory of the days of the week in Spanish. Remember: in Spanish, we do not use capital letters for days unless they start a sentence!

Answer Key: 1.C, 2.A, 3.True, 4.jueves, 5.B, 6.False (it is Saturday), 7.domingo, 8.B, 9.lunes, 10.A. Note: Ensure pupils have used lowercase letters for answers 4, 7, and 9.

6. 6. True or False: 'domingo' is the Spanish word for Monday. (1 mark)

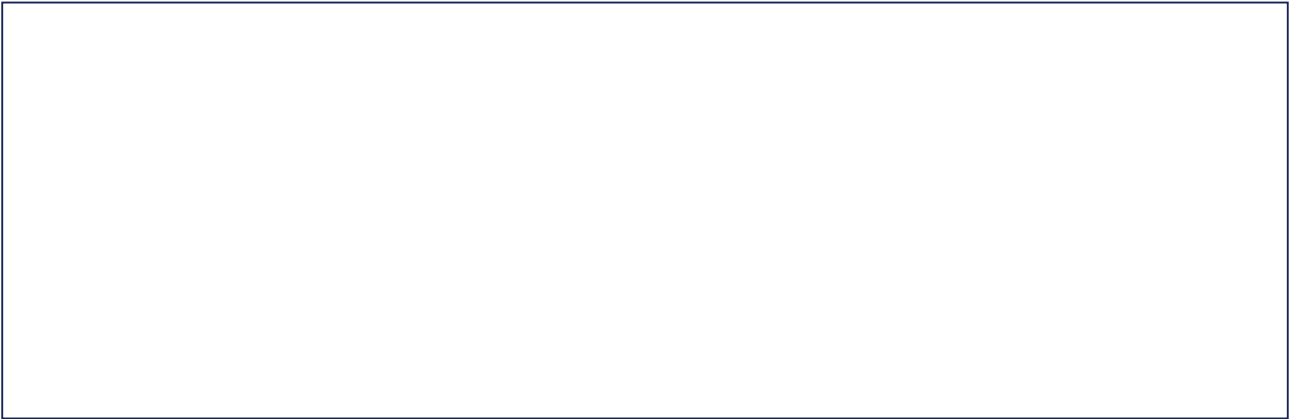
7. 7. Rosa rests on the final day of the week. Write the Spanish word for Sunday. (1 mark)

8. 8. Which day is 'martes'? A) Monday B) Tuesday* C) Wednesday D) Thursday (1 mark)

9. 9. Rosa starts her week at school on... (What is the Spanish word for Monday?) (1 mark)

10. 10. Which of these is spelled correctly? A) miércoles* B) miercoles C) Miercoles D) miercolès (1 mark)
