

Rosa's Weekly Diary: Mi Diario de la Semana

Learning objective: To be able to recall and write the days of the week in Spanish and describe a simple activity for each day.

Join Rosa the parrot! She loves to plan her week in Spanish. Use the word bank below to fill in your own diary. For each day, write the Spanish name for the day and a short sentence about what you did, using the format: 'El [day], yo [activity].'

Word bank: lunes (Monday) · martes (Tuesday) · miércoles (Wednesday) · jueves (Thursday) · viernes (Friday) · sábado (Saturday) · domingo (Sunday) · jugar (to play) · leer (to read) · cantar (to sing) · dibujar (to draw)

1. Lunes and Martes: Write the names of these two days in Spanish and describe one thing you did on each day. (2 marks)

2. Miércoles and Jueves: Write the names of these two days in Spanish and describe one thing you did on each day. (2 marks)

3. Viernes: Write the name of this day in Spanish and one activity you enjoyed. (1 mark)

4. Sábado and Domingo: Write the names of these two days in Spanish and describe your favourite weekend activity. (2 marks)

5. Reflection: Which day of the week is your favourite in Spanish? Explain why using a full sentence. (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Can you add a Spanish adjective to your diary entries? For example, describe your day as 'divertido' (fun) or 'fantástico' (fantastic)!
