

Rosa's Spanish Picnic Party

Learning objective: To identify and use common Spanish food vocabulary to label a creative scene.

Help Rosa the parrot prepare for a picnic! Read the word bank carefully and label the items in your drawing. Make sure your illustrations are colourful and clear.

Draw: Create a detailed scene of a park picnic. Use a bright, cheerful art style. Include a chequered picnic blanket on green grass. Draw Rosa the parrot sitting near the blanket. Ensure there is enough space around the food items to write labels clearly in Spanish. Use bright colours for the fruit and textures for the bread and cheese.



Label words: la manzana (apple) · el queso (cheese) · el pan (bread) · la naranja (orange) · el agua (water) · las uvas (grapes) · el sándwich (sandwich)

Steps:

1. Draw a large picnic blanket in the centre of your page. On the blanket, draw three different types of food from the word bank. Label each food item using its correct Spanish name.
2. Rosa is very thirsty! Draw a bottle or a glass of water next to the food. Label it using the Spanish word for water.
3. Which food item from the list do you like best? Write a short sentence in English explaining why you included it in your picnic.

4. Translate this phrase into Spanish: 'The bread and the cheese'.
5. If Rosa wants to buy an apple for £0.50 and a sandwich for £2.00, how much does she spend in total?
