

Rosa's Spanish Cafe Menu Designer

Learning objective: To identify and use Spanish vocabulary for food and drink, and to construct simple sentences to describe preferences.

Rosa the parrot is opening a bilingual cafe! Use this template to create your own Spanish menu. Choose your favourite foods from the word bank, write their Spanish names, and explain why you like them in English or simple Spanish.

Word bank: la manzana (apple) · el plátano (banana) · el pan (bread) · la leche (milk) · el queso (cheese) · el agua (water) · la ensalada (salad) · el pollo (chicken) · Me gusta... (I like...) · No me gusta... (I do not like...)

1. My Breakfast Choice: Write the Spanish name of a food item you would serve for breakfast and draw it in your mind. (2 marks)

2. My Favourite Snack: Write the Spanish name of a healthy snack and explain why it is a good choice. (3 marks)

3. Preference Sentence: Use 'Me gusta' or 'No me gusta' followed by a food item to share your opinion on a classic dish. (2 marks)

4. The Price Tag: If a slice of 'el pan' costs 50p, how much would it cost to buy two slices for your friends? (2 marks)

5. Menu Description: Describe one meal on your menu using an adjective (e.g., 'el pan es delicioso' - the bread is delicious). (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Try to write a short dialogue between a customer and a waiter using: 'Por favor' (please) and 'Gracias' (thank you).
