

Rosa's Spanish Greeting Garden

Learning objective: To identify and use common Spanish greetings and farewells appropriately in different contexts.

Rosa the parrot has flown into a garden where everyone is saying hello and goodbye. Use the word bank to fill in the missing speech bubbles below. Choose the most polite or appropriate phrase for each situation described.

Word bank: ¡Hola! · Buenos días · Buenas tardes · Buenas noches · Adiós · Hasta luego

1. 1. It is 9:00 am and you meet your teacher at the school gate. What do you say? (2 marks)

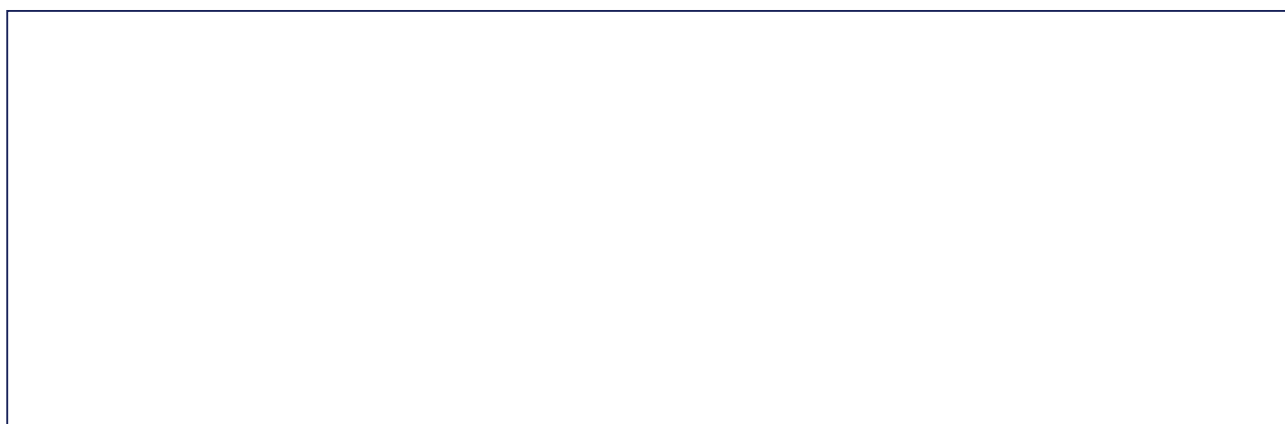
2. 2. You are playing in the park at 4:00 pm and a friend arrives. What is a friendly way to say hello? (2 marks)

3. 3. You are leaving your friend's house in the afternoon. What do you say to wave goodbye? (2 marks)

4. 4. It is 8:00 pm and you are going to bed. What do you say to your family? (2 marks)

5. 5. You see a neighbour at 3:00 pm. Which greeting is best to use? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Rosa the parrot sitting on a branch. In one speech bubble coming from Rosa, write '¡Hola!' and in another, write '¡Adiós!' as she flies away.



Extension challenge: Imagine you are meeting a new friend from Spain. Write a short sentence in Spanish to introduce yourself, using 'Me llamo...' followed by your name. Then, write one question you could ask them to find out how they are.
