

Rosa's Spanish Greeting Garden

Learning objective: To recall and use common Spanish greetings and introductions in a creative context.

Follow the drawing prompts below to create a scene where Rosa the parrot is meeting some new friends in the garden. Use the word bank to label your picture accurately.

Draw: Create a vibrant garden scene in a bright, colourful cartoon style. In the centre, draw Rosa the parrot perched on a tree branch. On the ground, draw another animal friend (like a squirrel or a rabbit). Include a bright sun in the corner and a clock attached to the tree trunk to show the time of day. Leave clear space around the characters for speech bubbles and labels.



Label words: ¡Hola! · Buenos días · Buenas tardes · ¿Cómo te llamas? · Me llamo... · Adiós

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw Rosa the parrot sitting on a branch. Add a speech bubble coming from her saying '¡Hola!' to a friend. (1 mark)
2. Step 2: Draw a sun high in the sky and label it 'Buenos días'. (1 mark)
3. Step 3: Draw a second animal character meeting Rosa. Label the speech bubble for the second character with 'Me llamo' followed by a name of your choice. (1 mark)
4. Step 4: Draw a clock showing the afternoon and label it 'Buenas tardes'. (1 mark)

5. Step 5: Write the Spanish phrase for 'Goodbye' near the bottom of your page where the characters are leaving. (1 mark)
