Join Rosa the parrot on a colourful language adventure—learn to say hello in Spanish!

- Use 'Buenos días' when the sun is rising to say good morning to your friends.
- Say 'Buenas tardes' during the afternoon, usually between lunchtime and sunset.
- Use 'Buenas noches' when it is dark outside to say goodnight or good evening.
- The word 'Hola' is used at any time of day to say hello, but remember—the 'h' is always silent!
- If someone asks '¿Cómo estás?', they are checking to see how you are feeling today.
- End your conversation with 'Adiós' when it is time to say goodbye.

Did you know? Did you know? Spanish is a 'Romance language', which means it comes from Latin, the language spoken by the Ancient Romans thousands of years ago! Rosa loves Spanish because it sounds just like a song when you speak it aloud.
