

Rosa's Hobbies Drawing Sheet

Learning objective: To learn and use Spanish vocabulary related to hobbies and interests.

Help Rosa the parrot create a visual diary of her friends' favourite hobbies. Follow the drawing prompts below and use the Spanish labels from the word bank to describe each scene.

Draw: Create a colourful grid on your page with four distinct sections. In each section, draw one of the BookFlik characters engaging in a hobby from the word bank. Use a fun, cartoon style with bright colours. Ensure that each character is clearly doing the activity (e.g., Finn splashing in water for 'nadar', Zara holding a paintbrush for 'pintar'). Leave space next to each character to write their Spanish hobby label clearly.



Label words: jugar al fútbol (playing football) · leer libros (reading books) · tocar la guitarra (playing the guitar) · pintar (painting) · nadar (swimming) · escuchar música (listening to music)

Steps:

1. Draw Pip the caterpillar in the top left corner enjoying his favourite hobby. Which Spanish phrase from the word bank describes this?
2. Draw Finn the dolphin in the bottom right corner. What is he doing? Label his hobby using the correct Spanish phrase.
3. If Max the monkey is playing an instrument, which phrase from the word bank would you use to label your

drawing?

4. Choose one of your own hobbies. Draw yourself doing it in the centre of the page and write the Spanish phrase underneath.
5. Why is it helpful to learn the Spanish words for hobbies when meeting new friends?
