

Class 4 Spanish Assessment: Mi Escuela (My School)

Learning objective: To identify and describe school subjects, classroom objects, and express opinions about learning in Spanish.

Read each question carefully and answer in the space provided. You may use the word bank to help you with your spellings.

Rosa the parrot is flying around the classroom. She says: '¡Hola! Today I am looking at my favourite subjects. I love painting in Art, but I find Maths a bit tricky. In my backpack, I have my favourite storybook and a sharp pencil.'

Word bank: las matemáticas (maths) · el arte (art) · la educación física (PE) · la historia (history) · la lengua (language/English) · me gusta (I like) · no me gusta (I don't like) · el lápiz (pencil) · el libro (book) · la mochila (backpack) · fácil (easy) · difícil (difficult)

1. 1. Look at the passage. Which subject does Rosa say she finds 'a bit tricky' (difficult)? (1 mark)

2. 2. Translate these two classroom items into Spanish: A pencil and a book. (2 marks)

3. 3. If a student wants to say 'I like History', how would they write this in Spanish? (2 marks)

4. 4. Match the following English subjects to their Spanish names: A) PE, B) Art, C) Language. (Write the letter next to the correct Spanish word: la educación física, la lengua, el arte). (3 marks)

5. 5. Rosa thinks Art is fun, but Maths is difficult. Write two sentences in Spanish describing how you feel about two different school subjects using 'Me gusta' or 'No me gusta'. (4 marks)

6. 6. Imagine you are packing your school bag. List three items you would put in your 'mochila' using the Spanish words for those items. (3 marks)

7. 7. Extended Writing: Write a short paragraph (4-5 sentences) introducing yourself to a new Spanish student. Include your name, two subjects you like, one subject you find 'difícil', and one item you have in your bag. (5 marks)

Draw: Draw your ideal school desk. Label at least three items on the desk using the correct Spanish words (e.g., 'el libro', 'el lápiz').
