

Rosa's Spanish Clock Shop

Learning objective: To learn how to tell the time in Spanish, focusing on 'Es la...' for one o'clock and 'Son las...' for other hours.

Rosa the parrot is opening a clock shop! She needs your help to label the clocks correctly. Match the Spanish time phrases from the word bank to the correct clock times listed in the questions. Remember: use 'Es la una' for 1:00 and 'Son las...' for all other hours.

Word bank: Es la una · Son las dos · Son las cuatro · Son las seis · Son las ocho · Son las diez

1. The shop clock shows 1:00. How do you say this in Spanish? (2 marks)

2. A customer asks for the time. The clock shows 2:00. Write the Spanish phrase. (2 marks)

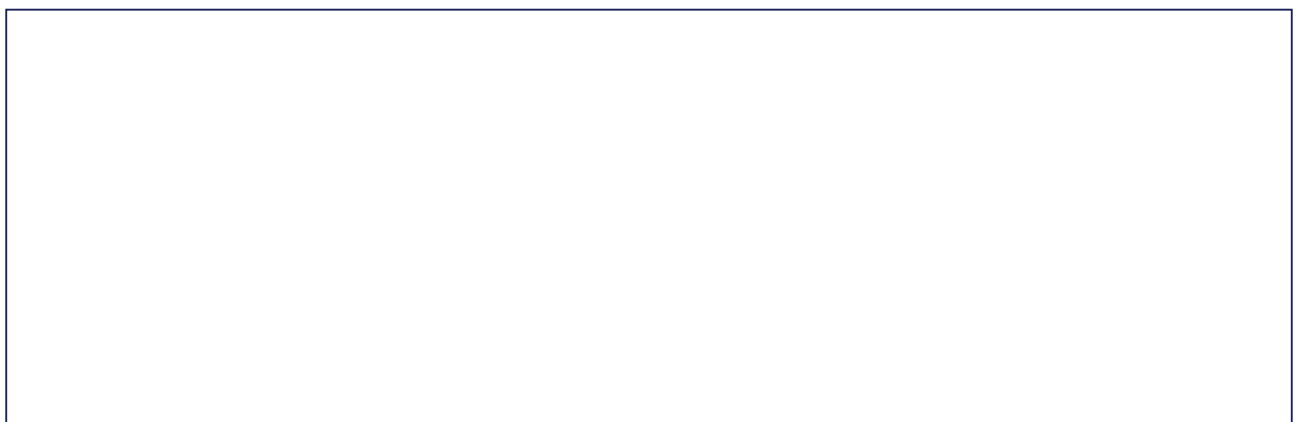
3. Rosa checks the time for her lunch break. The clock shows 4:00. Write the Spanish phrase. (2 marks)

4. The shop closes at 6:00. How do you say this in Spanish? (2 marks)

5. Rosa wakes up at 8:00. Write the Spanish phrase. (2 marks)

6. It is time for bed at 10:00. Write the Spanish phrase. (2 marks)
