

Rosa's Weather Adventure

Learning objective: To learn and use Spanish vocabulary related to weather by creating an illustrated weather map.

Rosa the parrot wants to share the weather report with you! Follow the drawing prompts to create a colourful weather map. Use the word bank to label your pictures correctly in Spanish.

Draw: Create a landscape-style weather map. In the centre, draw Rosa the parrot flying with a map in her wing. In the four corners, draw the weather symbols described in the questions. Keep the style clear and bright, using colour to represent the different types of weather (e.g., yellow for sun, blue for rain, white for snow).



Label words: Hace sol (It is sunny) · Hace viento (It is windy) · Está nublado (It is cloudy) · Llueve (It is raining) · Nieva (It is snowing)

Steps:

1. Draw a bright yellow sun in the top left corner. Label this in Spanish using the word bank.
2. Draw three grey clouds in the top right corner. Label this in Spanish.
3. Draw raindrops falling in the bottom left corner. Label this in Spanish.
4. Draw a snowy mountain peak in the bottom right corner. Label this in Spanish.
5. Look at the word 'viento'. Can you draw a kite blowing in the wind in the centre of your page and label it?
