

Zara's Creative Collage Corner

Get creative with Zara the Zebra: Snip, Stick, and Layer your way to a masterpiece!

- **Collage is an artistic technique where different materials like paper, fabric, and photographs are glued onto a backing surface to create a new image.**
- **Texture is important in collage; by mixing smooth paper with rough cardboard or shiny foil, you can make your artwork feel more exciting to look at.**
- **Overlap your shapes to create depth; placing one piece slightly over another helps your viewer understand which objects are in the foreground and which are in the background.**
- **Think about your colour palette before you start; choosing colours that contrast well can make your main subject stand out clearly from the background.**
- **Always arrange your pieces before you stick them down; this allows you to experiment with your composition until you are happy with the layout.**

Did you know? Did you know? The word 'collage' comes from the French verb 'coller', which means 'to glue'. Artists have been using this technique for over a hundred years to turn everyday scraps into brilliant works of art!
