3. 3. What is the term for a drawing that is exactly the same on both sides, like a butterfly wing or a spooky mask? (One word answer) (1 mark)

4. 4. If you want to make your art look 'spooky', which type of lighting creates the most dramatic shadows? A) Bright, flat light B) Low-angle light* C) Morning sunshine D) Soft, even light (1 mark)

5. 5. True or False: Using a bright neon pink would definitely help make a picture look mysterious and dark. (True/False) (1 mark)

6. 6. What do we call it when we place very different things together in art, like a bright white ghost against a pitch-black forest? (1 mark)

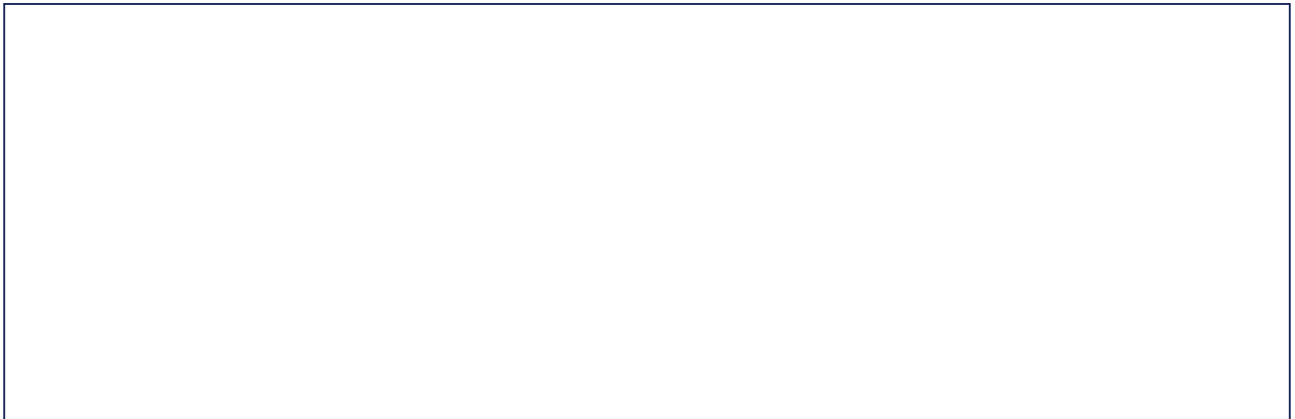
7. 7. True or False: Artists often use 'cool colours' like blue and violet to create a chilly, eerie atmosphere in their work. (True/False) (1 mark)

10. 10. Which of these materials would be best to create a 'rubbing' of a bumpy leaf for a nature-themed collage? A) A pencil and paper* B) A paintbrush and water C) A ruler D) A glue stick (1 mark)
