- **Composition** is the way you arrange the elements of your drawing on the page to guide the viewer's eye.
- **Collage** involves layering different textures, such as tissue paper, fabric, or recycled card, to build a 3D effect on your artwork.
- Using a colour wheel helps artists choose shades that complement each other to create a mood for a scene.
- Sketching light lines first allows you to plan your character's proportions before adding bold paint or ink outlines.
- Illustrators often use 'negative space'—the empty area around a subject—to make the main character stand out more clearly.
