Be a data detective: Sort, count, and make information clear!

- Data is simply a collection of facts or pieces of information, such as names, ages, or favourite colours, that we can organise to help us learn something new.
- Before you put data onto a computer, it is helpful to use a tally chart to count your findings accurately by grouping them into sets of five.
- A database is a digital filing system that allows you to store, search, and filter information quickly and easily.
- Bar charts are perfect for comparing different categories of data so you can see at a glance which item is the most or least popular.
- When handling data, it is important to ensure your information is accurate, relevant, and presented in a way that is easy for others to understand.
