1. Kit the Fox is setting up a new gaming profile. Why is it important that he does not use his real name, home address, or school name? Give two reasons. (2 marks)

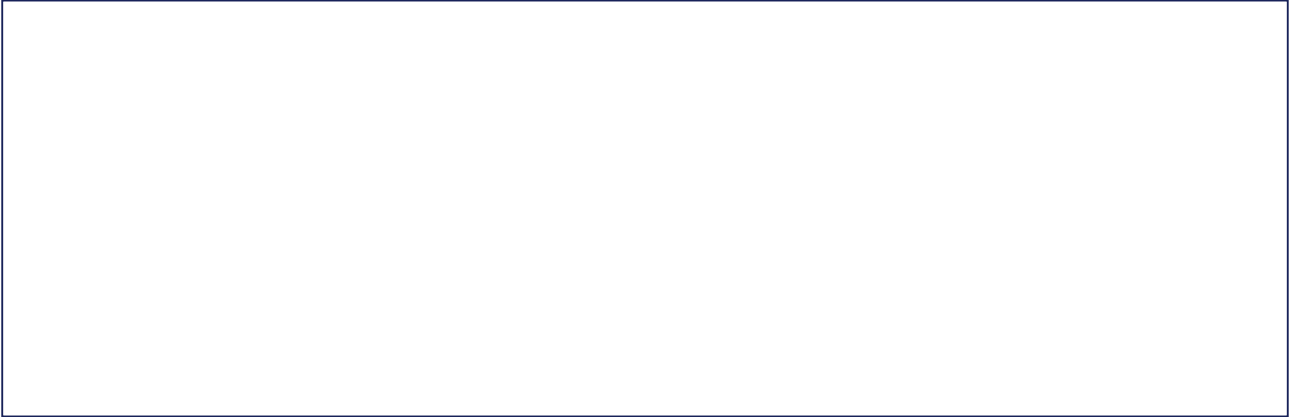
2. If someone you do not know sends you a message or asks you to play a game online, what is the best thing to do? Explain your steps. (2 marks)

4. You see something online that makes you feel worried, sad, or confused. Who should you tell and why is it important to talk to them? (2 marks)

5. Define 'cyberbullying' in your own words and describe one action you can take if you witness it happening to someone else. (2 marks)
