Learning objective: To understand and identify adverbs in context and use them appropriately.

Read the passage and answer the questions that follow. Use the word bank to identify and explain the adverbs used.

Max, the enthusiastic monkey, was helping with the daily chores in the jungle. He cleaned his room quickly and finished his homework swiftly. While eating his banana, he talked loudly with his friends. But after lunch, he played quietly with his toys, trying to be polite when his parents were nearby. He also read his storybook softly, so as not to disturb his baby sister.

Word bank: quickly · slowly · loudly · politely · softly

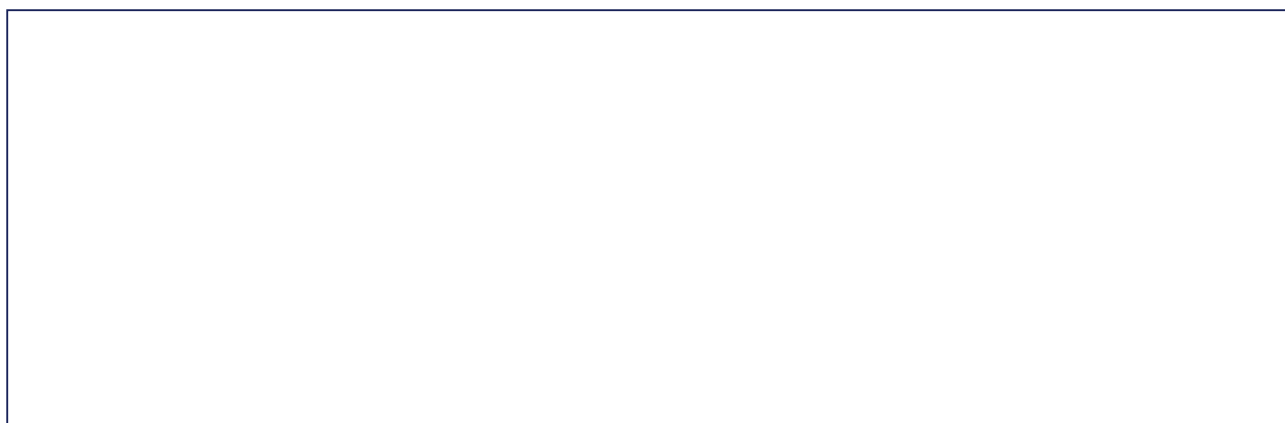
1. What adverb did Max use when he cleaned his room? (2 marks)

2. How did Max behave after lunch with his toys? (2 marks)

3. Why do you think Max read his book softly? (2 marks)

4. Can you think of a time when you needed to be quiet in a public place? Explain. (2 marks)
