Learning objective: To test and enhance understanding of adverbs and their usage in sentences.

Choose the correct answer for each question. Some questions will require a 1-word answer.

Pip the caterpillar was **quietly** reading his newest book. Nova the owl **often** asks questions about the night sky. Max the monkey solved a **quickly** moving puzzle with **well** thought-out answers.

1. Nova asks **loudly** about the stars. **False** (1 mark)

2. Max always thinks of puzzles as **maths** problems. **False** (1 mark)

3. Pip **always** reads his books. **False** (1 mark)

4. The passage uses the word **often** to describe Nova. **True** (1 mark)

5. Max solves the puzzle **quickly**. **True** (1 mark)

6. Which adverb from the list is used in the passage to describe how Nova acts? (1 mark)

7. How would you describe Pip's reading in the passage? (1 mark)

8. If Max was thinking about the puzzle, he might say it was a **difficult** one. Which adverb would best describe his method of solving it? (1 mark)

9. Which adverb shows that Nova does not always ask questions about the stars? (1 mark)

10. What does the passage imply about Pip's reading habit? (1 mark)
