

Celebrating Pioneers: Black History Month

Learning objective: To analyse the contributions of significant historical figures and reflect on the impact of their achievements on modern society.

Read each question carefully. Use your historical knowledge and creative writing skills to provide thoughtful, well-structured answers. Ensure you use appropriate vocabulary to describe courage, innovation, and perseverance.

This worksheet focuses on your knowledge of Black History Month. Think about the individuals who have campaigned for equality, changed the world of science, or inspired others through art and literature. Consider the challenges they faced and the lasting changes they helped bring about in the UK and around the world.

1. Identify one historical figure you have studied who campaigned for equality. Explain why their actions were significant at the time they were living. (2 marks)

2. Compare and contrast the challenges faced by a historical figure of your choice with the freedoms we enjoy today. How has their work contributed to modern society? (3 marks)

3. Define the word 'perseverance' in your own words. Justify your answer by linking it to a specific historical event or individual studied during Black History Month. (2 marks)

4. If you could interview a historical pioneer, what is one question you would ask them about their motivation to continue despite facing injustice? (1 mark)

5. What might happen if these pioneers had chosen not to speak out against injustice? Describe the potential impact on today's world. (3 marks)

6. Explain why it is important for us to celebrate the achievements of Black individuals throughout the entire year, rather than just during October. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a commemorative plaque that could be placed in a local park to honour a Black historical figure. Include symbols that represent their specific contribution to history (e.g., books for a writer, a telescope for a scientist, or a map for an explorer).



Extension challenge: Ellie the elephant is writing a history book. Write a persuasive paragraph explaining why a specific unsung hero of history deserves a chapter in her book. Use at least four words from the word bank and focus on the legacy they left behind.
