

BookFlik Book Review Illustration Task

Learning objective: To convey the atmosphere, setting, and key themes of a book through visual representation and descriptive labelling.

Use this sheet to create a vivid visual summary of a book you have recently read. Follow the steps to build your scene, then use the word bank to add descriptive labels that explain your artistic choices.

Draw: Draw a dynamic scene representing the climax of your book. Use the entire page. Ensure your drawing includes: 1) The main character in the centre, 2) A detailed background that shows where the story is taking place, 3) At least one object that represents a secret or a challenge the character faces. Use a 'close-up' perspective for the character to show their emotions clearly.



Label words: Atmospheric · Protagonist · Antagonist · Setting · Climax · Symbolism · Perspective · Vibrant

Steps:

1. Identify the protagonist of your book. Explain why you chose to draw them in a specific pose or setting to reflect their personality.
2. Compare and contrast the setting you have drawn with the actual location described in the book. Why did you choose to emphasise certain features?
3. Justify your choice of colour palette for this scene. How do these colours help the reader understand the

mood of the story?

4. What might happen to the characters if the setting of this story changed from a quiet library to a bustling, noisy market? Describe the visual impact.
5. Label your drawing with at least three words from the word bank, drawing lines to the specific parts of your art that represent these concepts.
6. Explain why visual illustrations are as important as written text when reviewing a book for other readers.
