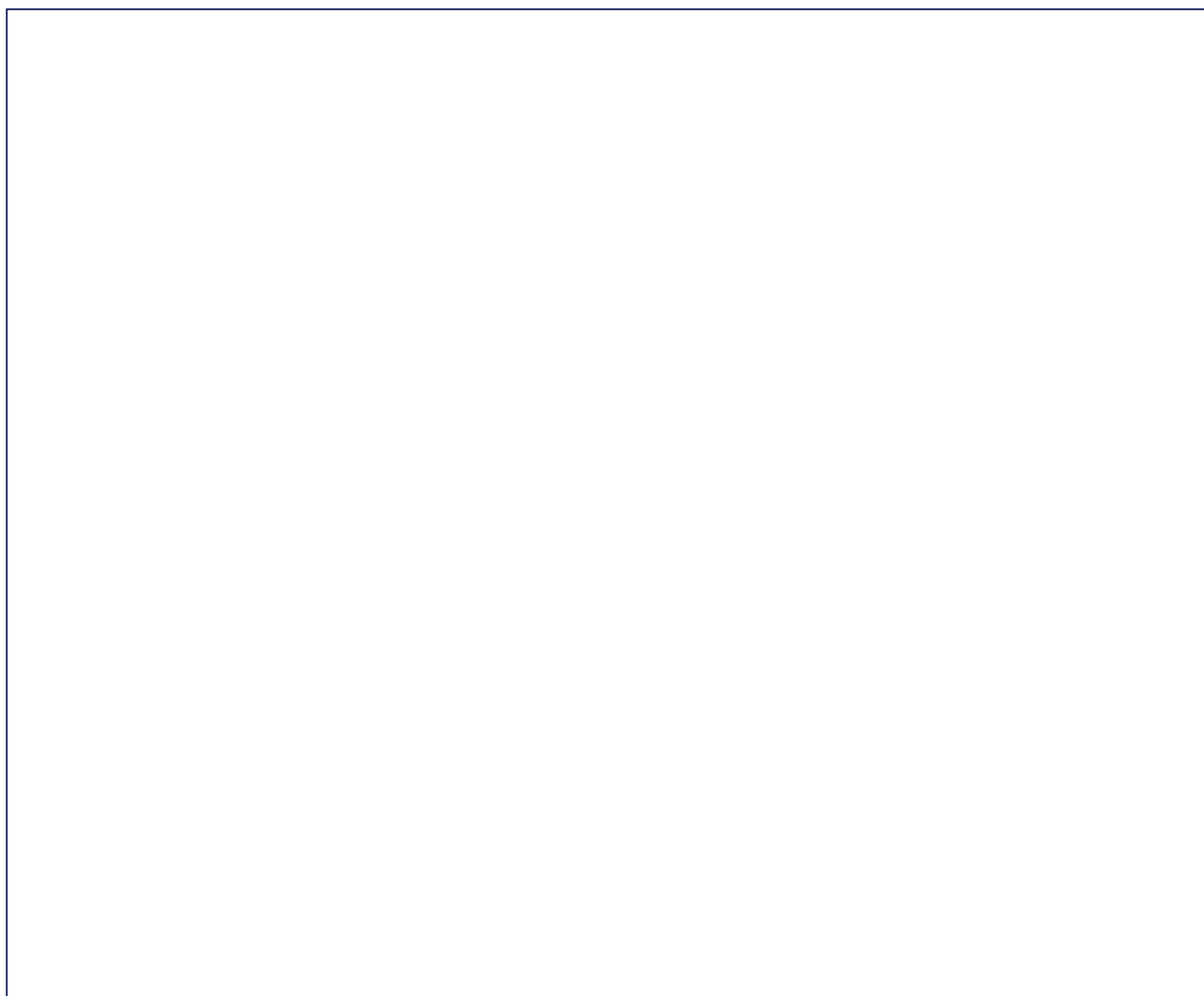


Character Creator: Designing a Hero

Learning objective: To use expanded noun phrases and precise adjectives to describe a character's appearance and personality.

Use your imagination to design a brand-new character. Draw them in the space provided and use the word bank to help you label their features. Once you have drawn them, answer the questions below to bring your character to life!

Draw: Draw a full-body portrait of your original character in the centre of the page. Use a clear, pencil-sketch style. Include at least one accessory they carry (like a satchel, a tool, or a special book). Ensure there is space around the character to draw lines and add labels from your word bank.



Label words: shimmering · determined · spectacles · weather-beaten · enormous · dazzling · courageous · intricate · vibrant · gentle

Steps:

1. Choose two adjectives from the word bank to describe your character's personality. Explain why you chose these words.
2. Write an expanded noun phrase to describe one item your character is holding (e.g., 'a dusty, leather-bound map').

3. What is one secret talent your character has? Use a full sentence to describe it.
4. If your character found a £5 note on the ground, would they spend it or save it? Explain your answer.
5. Label your drawing with three adjectives that describe your character's clothing or physical appearance.
