

Character Creator: My BookFlik Friend

Learning objective: To use expanded noun phrases and precise adjectives to write a detailed character description.

Today, we are going to use our imaginations to build a brand new character! Think about what they look like, how they move, and what makes their personality special. Use the boxes below to build your character profile. Remember to include exciting adjectives and interesting verbs to help your reader picture your character clearly.

1. Character Identity: Give your character a name and describe their species or type. Are they an animal, a creature from another planet, or a magical being? (2 marks)

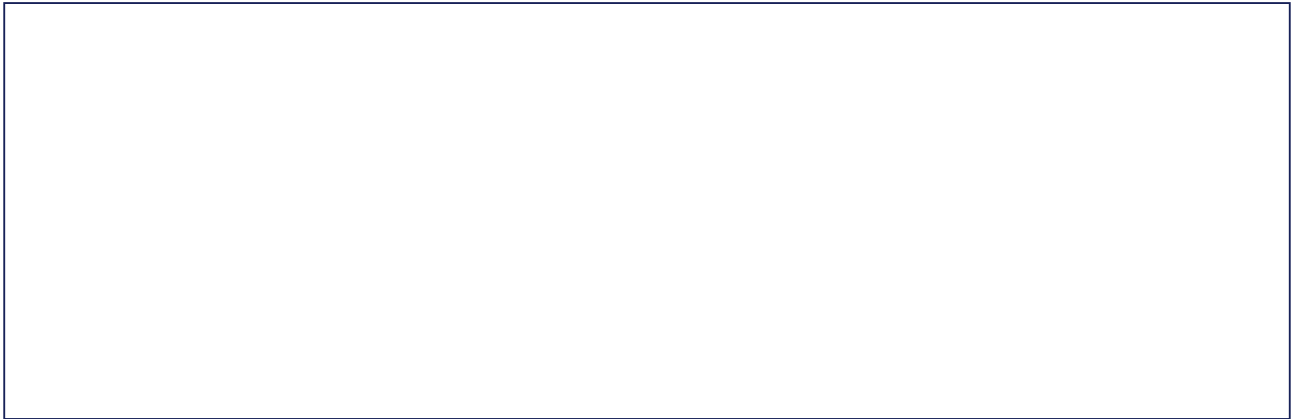
2. Physical Appearance: Describe what your character looks like. Think about their fur, scales, or feathers. What colours are they? How big or small are they? (3 marks)

3. Personality and Traits: What is your character like on the inside? Are they brave like Leo the Lion, or curious like Nova the Owl? What do they love to do? (3 marks)

4. Special Movements: How does your character travel? Do they stomp, glide, scuttle, or leap? Use an adverb to describe their movement (e.g., 'they glide silently'). (2 marks)

5. Favourite Possession: If your character carried one special item with them, what would it be and why is it important to them? (2 marks)

Draw: In the space below, draw a detailed portrait of your character. Make sure your drawing matches the descriptions you wrote in your profile!



Extension challenge: Write a short paragraph explaining where your character lives. Use a fronted adverbial to start your sentence, for example: 'Deep within the ancient, whispering forest, my character spends their days...'
