

Easter Story Sequencing

Learning objective: To understand the Easter story timeline and sequence of events.

Sort the events of the Easter story into the correct order. Match the event to the correct number on the timeline.

The Easter story is about the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ. Here are some important events in the story. Can you put them in the correct order?

Word bank: Easter Bunny · Jesus Christ · Resurrection · Crucifixion · Holy Week · Palm Sunday · Good Friday · Easter Sunday

1. Palm Sunday: Jesus enters Jerusalem, where he is welcomed by the crowd. (1 mark)

2. Holy Week: A week of special events leading up to Easter. (1 mark)

3. Crucifixion: Jesus is nailed to the cross and dies. (1 mark)

4. Resurrection: Jesus returns to life on Easter Sunday. (1 mark)

5. Easter Bunny: A mythical character associated with Easter egg hunting. (1 mark)

6. Good Friday: The day of Jesus' crucifixion. (1 mark)

7. Easter Sunday: The day of Jesus' resurrection. (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a picture of the Easter story timeline, including the events we have matched.



Extension challenge: Write a short paragraph about the significance of Easter and why it is an important holiday for Christians.
