3. How does the colour of eggs relate to the Easter story? (1 mark)

4. What is the importance of the last supper in the Easter story? (2 marks)

5. What is resurrection and how does it relate to Jesus Christ? (3 marks)

6. Imagine you are an artist creating a picture to represent the Easter story. What would you draw and why? (4 marks)

7. Write a short paragraph explaining why the Easter story is important to Christians. (5 marks)
