Learning objective: To practise consistent, joined-up handwriting while using descriptive vocabulary to develop a character profile.

Choose one of your favourite BookFlik characters (like Pip the bookworm or Nova the owl). Using your neatest, most consistent joined-up handwriting, fill in the details below. Focus on keeping your letter sizes even, your spacing clear, and your joins smooth.

1. Character Name and Appearance: Introduce your chosen character and describe their most distinctive physical features. Remember to sit your letters carefully on the line. (3 marks)

2. Personality Traits: Explain why this character is unique. Use two adjectives from the word bank to justify your answer. (3 marks)

3. The Great Adventure: Describe a challenge your character might face. What might happen if they lost their favourite item? Explain their reaction. (4 marks)

4. Compare and Contrast: If your character met another BookFlik friend, how would their personalities differ? Justify your comparison. (4 marks)

5. The Hidden Secret: Every great character has a secret. Describe what your character is hiding and why it is important to them. (3 marks)

6. Self-Reflection: Review your handwriting. Which letter join did you find the most challenging to write neatly? How will you improve it next time? (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Write a short poem about your character on a separate sheet of paper. Ensure your poem uses at least three examples of alliteration and maintain your high standard of handwriting throughout.
