

Pip the Bookworm's Library Adventure

Learning objective: To identify and label key features of a book whilst developing fine motor skills through colouring.

Read the fun facts about books and then colour in the scene. Use the labels to identify the different parts of the book Pip is reading.

Colour this: A large, friendly, smiling caterpillar named Pip wearing round spectacles. Pip is curled up comfortably on a giant, open hardcover book. The scene is set inside a cosy library with shelves full of books in the background. Steps:
