

BookFlik Character Profile: Exploring Personalities

Learning objective: To analyse a character's traits and motivations using evidence from a text.

Read the story passage carefully. Think about what the character says, does, and feels. Use the template below to describe your chosen character. Remember to provide evidence from the text to support your ideas.

Word bank: personality · characteristic · motivation · evidence · opinion · behaviour · adjective

1. Character Name and Role: Who is the character and what is their main role in the story? (2 marks)

2. Personality Traits: Identify two personality traits for this character and use an adjective to describe each one. (3 marks)

3. Evidence Hunt: Find a specific moment in the story where the character shows their personality. What did they do or say? (3 marks)

4. Character Motivation: Why do you think the character acted the way they did in the story? What were they trying to achieve? (3 marks)

5. Personal Reflection: If you could meet this character, what is one question you would ask them and why? (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Write a short paragraph predicting how this character might behave if they were placed in a completely different setting, such as a busy marketplace or a quiet library.
