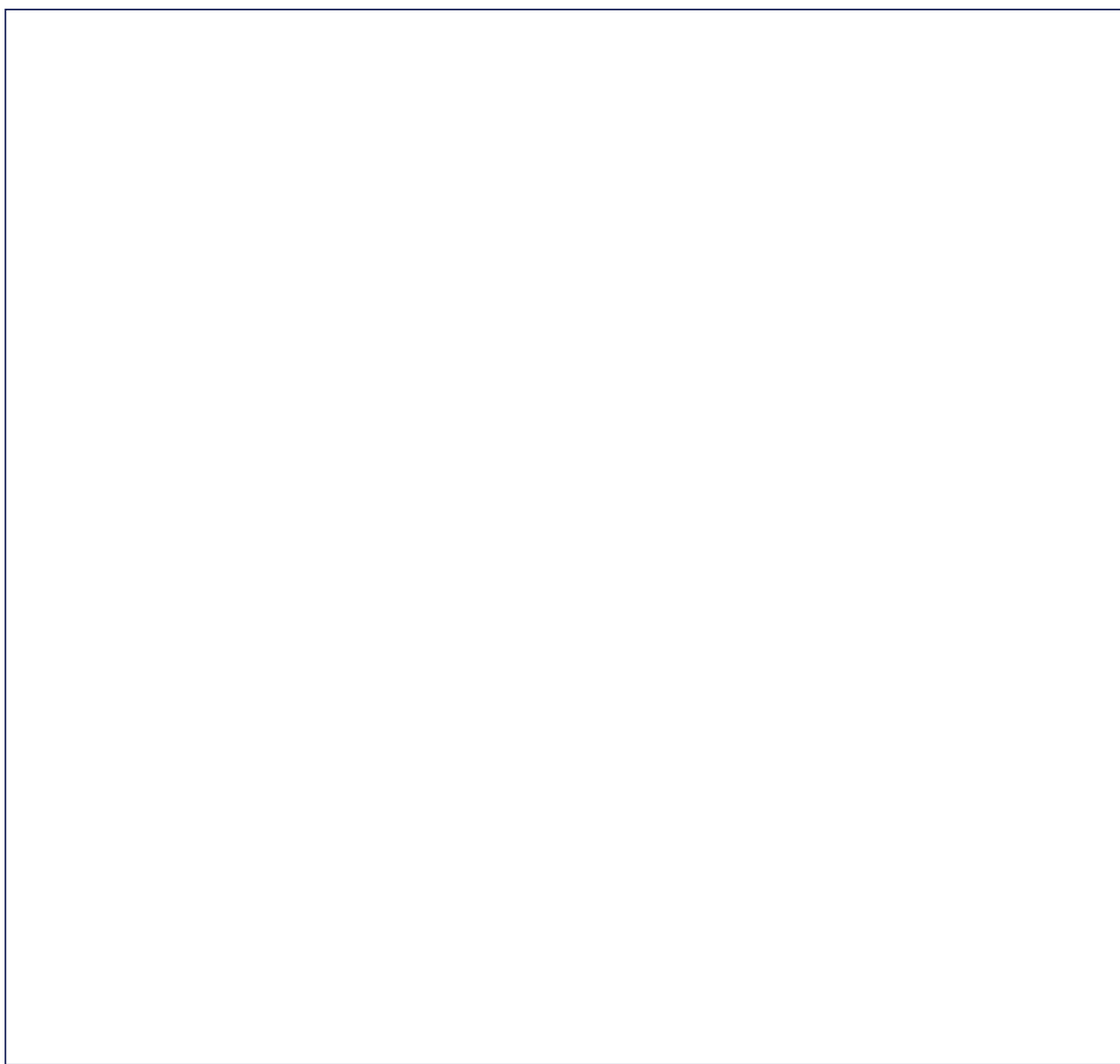


Pip's Spelling Garden

Learning objective: To practise spelling common Year 3 and 4 challenge words whilst developing fine motor skills through colouring.

Colour in the scene below. Look carefully at the words written on the flower petals and the butterflies. Make sure you spell them correctly if you add any extra labels of your own!

Colour this: A cheerful, detailed garden scene. In the centre, Pip the caterpillar (a friendly, segmented caterpillar with a small smile and antennae) is resting on a large, broad leaf. Surrounding Pip are three large, detailed flowers. The petals of the flowers contain the words 'calendar', 'separate', and 'believe' written in clear, traceable font. Steps:
