**1. Where does the story begin? (1 mark)**

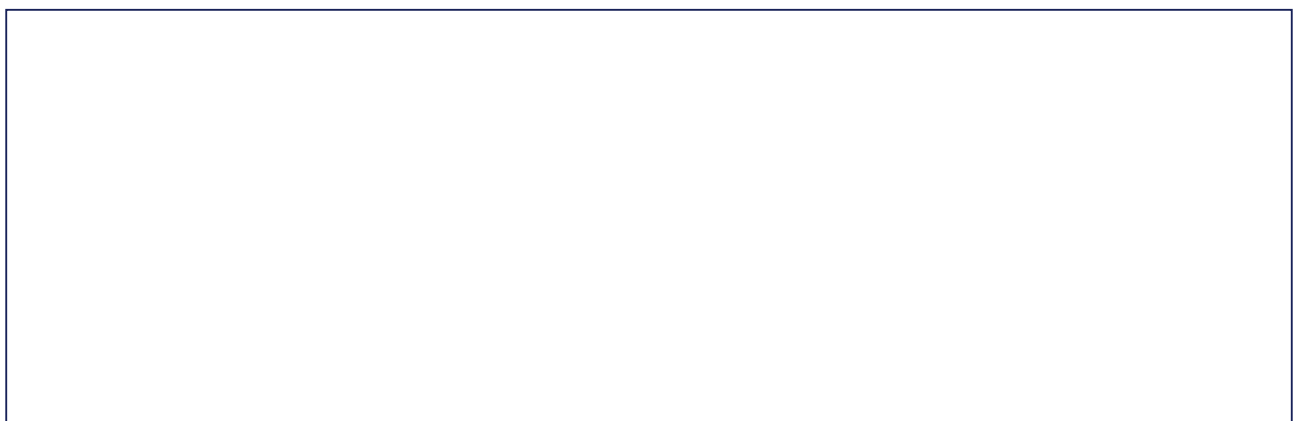
**2. What is the exciting part of the story? (1 mark)**
